Minutes of the extra-ordinary meeting held on Wednesday 20th June 2018 at 7.00pm in the Village Hall.

1. Welcome and apologies for absence.

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies were received from Cllr N Curl and Cllr T Irons.

2. To receive declarations of interests.

There were none received.

3. To discuss the way forward in respect of the grass cutting contract.

It was agreed that the current contractor had let the council down badly, in that he had only turned up once this year and had been difficult to contact or pin down as to when he will be in the village again. It was agreed the contract has been dissolved and the Clerk should send an appropriate letter.

Cllr Brown proposed that the local resident who has kindly agreed to continue to mow the paths on the common for the remainder of the year be reimbursed with expenses, this was seconded by Cllr Dennis and unanimously agreed. The Clerk will send an appropriate letter.

Council also thanked Cllr Collinge for cutting the churchyard and it was agreed to reimburse any expenses.

Cllr Green volunteered to trim the splay at the top of School Road.

Cllr Green proposed the following for the remainder of the year:

- A new contractor, who had provided a quotation, be appointed to cut the amenity area and as much of the play area and allotments as possible, including the overspill car park.
- A second new contractor, who had provided a quotation, be appointed to cut the churchyard, trim Patch Corner and the Village Hall.
- A professional sprayer be sought to weed spray where required.

This was seconded by Cllr Brown and unanimously agreed.

Cllr Dennis will continue to research the possibility of purchasing a mower etc for next year.

4. To confirm that the next meeting of Brisley Parish Council will be held at 7.00pm on Wednesday 4th July 2018 at Brisley Village Hall.
